

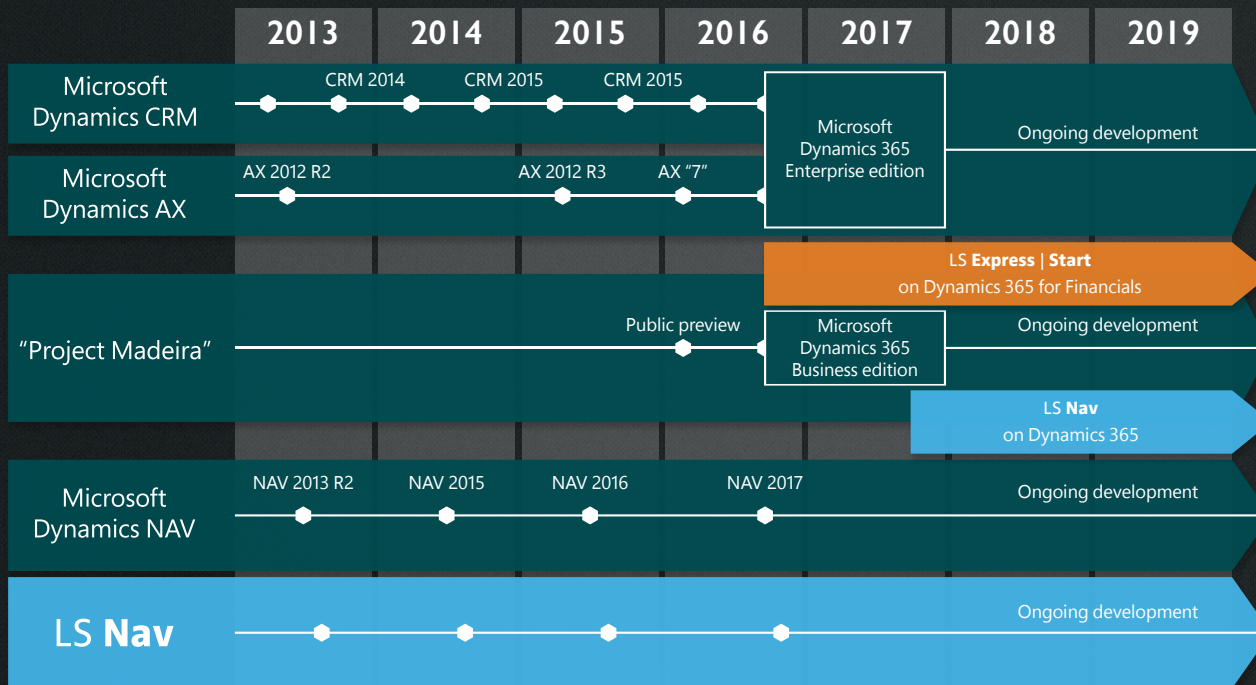
Microsoft Dynamics NAV and LS Nav : a bright future

Microsoft Dynamics NAV: a long-term commitment

Microsoft has committed to **continued development and enhancement of Microsoft Dynamics NAV** as an **on-premises** solution for the foreseeable and unforeseeable future.

In addition, Microsoft has introduced a new offering of Dynamics NAV in the cloud, **Dynamics 365 Business edition** (introduced in early 2016 as "Project Madeira").



Microsoft Dynamics NAV will continue to be developed both as an on-premises solution and as Software as a Service (SaaS) in Dynamics 365.

LS Retail: continued development on-premises and in the cloud

LS Retail will continue to invest in, develop and support **LS Nav as an on-premises solution**.

At the same time, on December 1st 2016 we introduced an entry-level retail POS solution on the Dynamics 365 Business edition, **LS Express Start** for Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Financials.

In the coming Dynamics 365 releases LS Retail also plans to offer **LS Nav as a full-blown solution in the cloud, on the Dynamics 365 platform**.

LS Nav customers will therefore have the **choice to run their system on-premises or as Software as a Service (SaaS)** in the cloud as part of Dynamics 365. This offering will also include total integration with other products in the Microsoft stack such as Office 365, Power BI, Cortana and Azure.
